	AUTUMN MAGIC (Aronia melanocarpa 'Autumn Magic')		
	Zone 4 Masses of fragrant white flowers in spring are followed by clusters of glossy purple-black fruit that persist into winter. Lustrous green foliage turns vibrant red and purple in fall. Upright spreading shrub grows to 3-5'.

	Zone 4 Fragrant white flowers in spring followed by bright red glossy berries. Shiny dark green foliage turns brilliant scarlet red in fall. Upright rounded shrub grows to 6-8'.

	CITY SLICKER® (Betula nigra 'Whit XXV') PP #16573 P3		
	Zone 5 Creamy-white bark develops at an early age. Moderately sized dark green leaves turn gold in fall. Grows in heavy alkaline clay soils as well as sandy soils. Heat and drought tolerant. <i>Plus \$.75 Royalty. Grown on their own root.</i>

New	WHITESPIRE JR (Betula populifolia)		
	Zone 3 Narrow upright tree for cool climates. Bright green leaves turn yellow in fall. Older trees develop chalky white bark that does not peel. A good selection for poor soils and other difficult sites. Resistant to bronze birch borer. <i>Singles for clumping.</i>

	NORTHERN CATALPA (<i>Catalpa speciosa</i>)		
	Zone 4 Very adaptable native tree. Large, heart-shaped leaves and large clusters of fragrant, white, bell-shaped flowers in early summer; long fruits resemble slender bean pods in Autumn.

	CHINESE FRINGETREE (<i>Chionanthus retusus</i>)		
	Zone 5 Elegant accent tree for small urban spaces. Abundant starry-white, fragrant flowers at the new branch tips, cinnamon-colored exfoliating bark. Lustrous, leathery, bright green leaves.

	RED OBELISK (<i>Fagus sylvatica</i> 'Red Obelisk')

	ROHANI PURPLE (Fagus sylvatica 'Rohanii')		
	Zone 5 An upright spreading tree, developing a rounded crown with age. Leaves are purple-brown with rounded lobes, similar to the outline of oak leaves. Attractive bark is smooth and silvery-gray.

	Zone 4 Purple leaves are edged and striped with rose and pinkish-white border. Plant in part shade to protect leaves from hot afternoon sun scorch.

	MUNCHKIN OAKLEAF (Hydrangea quercifolia 'Munchkin')		
	Zone 5 Blossoms open white, age to pink, and are robust, remaining upright even after heavy rains. Foliage turns brilliant mahogany in fall. Exceptional compact form and dense plant habit suitable for smaller landscape areas.

New	RUBY SLIPPERS OAKLEAF (Hydrangea quercifolia 'Munchkin')		
	Zone 5 Large flowers start white and slowly change color to pink, maturing to ruby red. Oak-like foliage turns mahogany-red in autumn. Exceptional compact form and dense plant habit suitable for smaller landscape areas.

New	GRO-LOW FRAGRANT (Rhus aromatica 'Gro-Low') Zone 3 Aromatic tiny yellow flowers in spring, followed by hairy red fruit. Low, wide spreading habit with orange-red fall foliage. Popular fast growing shrub often planted in mass beds or for bank stabilization.

New	SHIROBANA (Spiraea japonica 'Shirobana') Zone 4 Deep rose, pink and white flower clusters on the same compact, mounded shrub. Lustrous deep green leaves.

	SYRINGA (Lilac)		
New	DWARF KOREAN (Syringa meyeri 'Palibin') Zone 3 Reddish purple buds open to striking spikes of fragrant pale lilac-pink flowers in late spring. Small rounded, dark green foliage emerges burgundy in spring and turns coppery in fall and is resistant to mildew. Dainty, compact uniform ball shape.

	Zone 3 Re-blooming small, rounded form with fragrant violet-purple flowers in late spring and again in early fall. Hardy, mildew resistant foliage.

New	HARVEST GOLD® (Tilia x mongolica 'Harvest Gold') PP 12,232 Zone 3 Excellent upright growth habit, exfoliating bark, attractive glossy foliage that consistently turns a golden fall color. Golden buds turn brown in late winter. Resistant to sun scald and leaf spot. <i>Plus \$.75 Royalty.</i>

	 ULMUS (Elm)		
New	NEW HARMONY AMERICAN (Ulmus americana 'New Harmony') Zone 5 Upright, broadly vase-shaped form with dense canopy and slender, often drooping, branches. Medium green foliage in summer with yellow fall foliage. Insect and disease resistant. Urban and drought tolerant. <i>Grown on their own root.</i>

New	BURKWOOD (<i>Viburnum x burkwoodii</i>) Zone 5 Flowers are pink in bud, opening to pure white in mid-Spring with spicy fragrance. Foliage is lustrous dark green. Fruit is red, changing to black but can be sparse and insignificant. Maroon fall color.
